She has met with the Dean of Curriculum to discuss plans to update the PCAH and develop long-term infrastructure to ensure they have the infrastructure, resources, and systems in place for new programs. She does not anticipate there will be significant changes to the application process. The goal is for the applications to be released on or before December 15 and due on January 15 to honor the deadline

and the UC and CSU consultation process.
