1. Review of minutes: August

2. ASCCC Update (Cheryl Aschenbach)

Cheryl Aschnbach shared the ASCCC is working on a proposal to align the CCC community college general education patterns (for associate degrees and baccalaureate degrees) with the proposed CalGETC pattern.

## 3. CCCCO Update (Candice Brooks/Sean Madden)

Madden reported the following:

- Dr. Brooks has transitioned out of the Chancellor's Office;
- The internal review and scoring of BDP applications is complete;
- Bakersfield College was added to the colleges notified of approval status.
- Conditional approval was sent to BOG president for final approval;
- The CCCCO is redesigning the BPD application for cycle 2-they plan to release it in early October with a January 13, 2023 due date;
- The BDP Workgroup is scheduled to meet in September;
- Athird workgroup is being established to focus on professional development;

## Questions/Comments

Dekloe, Solano, said he was surprised by the CSU objections for Moorpark's proposal because it was based on Solano and MiraCosta's degrees.

Madden said he will review the specific concerns. He mentioned the approval of Feather River, San Diego City, and Moorpark college's programs are pending intersegmental discussion.

Madden explained the UC does not have any objections to the programs. The CCCCO is exploring the possibility of front loading intersegmental discussions at the beginning of the BPD approval process. some of the Sean will review the specific concerns.

The discussion regarding CSU objections continued. It was also mentioned that McGrath has inquired about workforce need and the possibility of additional legislation to allow for nursing programs.

Aquestion was asked which applications were approved. Grande posted a <u>link</u> to the letter BOG President Haynes. Overview of application statuses:

Six Programs were presented for approval: El Camino, Respiratory Care; De Anza, Automotive Technology Management; Bakersfield, Research Laboratory Technology; Crafton Hills, Respiratory Care; Mt. SAC, Histotechnology; Foothill, Respiratory Care

Finalizing CSU Duplication Concerns: Feather River, Ecosystem Restoration/Applied Fire; San Diego City, Cyber Defense and Analysis; Moorpark, Biomanufacturing

Not Approved: LA Valley, Respiratory Therapy

The MOU with UCLA is expiring. UCLA received grant **Goffletures** and they are interested in continued collaboration with the BDP for 3 new studies.
